## **ATTENTION: TOILET & SEWAGE WASTE**

In order to keep association dues down, please make sure you are only flushing appropriate toiletries down the toilet and drains. Only toilet paper and noted flushable items should be flushed. The plumbing company is reporting many hair extensions and other inappropriate items are being flushed down the toilet and backing up the community's sewage system. It has been reported that cooking grease and like products have been cause for recent back ups in

the community plumbing. Fats, oils, and grease come from meats, butters and margarine, lard, food scraps, sauces, salad dressings, dairy products, and cooking oil. When fats, oils and grease (F.O.G.) goes down the drain, it hardens and causes sewer pipes to clog. This can lead to a Sanitary Sewer Overflow where raw sewage actually backs up into your home, lawn, neighborhood, and streets. Not only does this nasty mess cause health issues, it also can run into a nearby stream or river which affects our drinking water. If your pipes become clogged from putting these products down the drain, it can be a very expensive problem to fix.
